We are not required to have a full audit, but we do require an independent external examination of our accounts and I would propose that, in view of their excellent work and very competitive cost, we ask CRASL to carry out that work again in the future.

This financial statement is accurate, but of course, fund raising has been on-going for over two years and because the United Church facilitated grants from organisations that would

only support registered charities, it doesn't give the full picture of the costs involved the Church and Church Square.

Out of interest I can confirm that, in total the Church Square fund has received;

Financial support of from numerous people and organisations to the tune of	£297,000
Non-financial support, i.e. providing products or goods or labour of circa	£ 35,000

The overall cost being in the region of £330,000
