

**Leiston Community Land Trust  
Treasurers Report 2022 to 2023**

Our financial report has been prepared by independent accountants CRASL and is available on line.

In summary during the period of these accounts i.e. the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 23 we received;

Total income of	22,071
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This income was purely from grants and donations, largely to the Church square  
The only other income was via electricity Sales (simply to facilitate electricity to the dive shop) of £440.00

Our expenditure during this accounting period was	32,226
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In broad terms our expenses, consisted of;

Payment for works at Church Square	21418
Subscriptions	673
Electric (less refunds from the dive shop making actual cost 287)	728
Insurance	225
Accountancy	432
Pr	1163
Sundry / Stationary / Signage	1587
Professional Fees (Feasibility study regarding Sizewell Road – grant funded	6000

Although expenditure exceeded income this was budgeted expenditure from grant funds gathered during the previous year.

I would recommend approval CRASL's financial statement

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We are not required to have a full audit, but we do require an independent external examination of our accounts and I would propose that, in view of their excellent work and very competitive cost, we ask CRASL to carry out that work again in the future.
